Brian,

Thanks for taking my call – for what it is worth I appreciate your words and understand your frustration with the matter.

As per our conversation, I will attach a copy of the following items:

1. **SETTLEMENT OFFER** – On November 7, 2013, I tried to keep the investor involved in the investment at Deercrest by sending this letter to the BCSC. They did not reply to my request until December 31, 2013 – some 7 weeks after it was sent.
2. **BCSC REPLY** – dated December 31, 2013 – this was their reply to my offering to keep the investors involved in the project.
3. **BCSC re ENVISION ACCOUNT** – this is a letter from Kerkhoff's lawyer to the BCSC indicating they were willing to take over the project and that Wharram was to have NOTHING to do with the project. NOTE: At the bottom of page 1 it discusses the motivation behind Wharram doing the project and what he was trying to complete.

As we discussed today, there are 2 different stories behind what the BCSC alleged and what was the truth. The Panel found that I did not commit fraud in the amount of \$5.45 million. I continue to fight for the truth and will not stop until it is told.

If you have any comments regarding the attachments and would like to discuss further – please do not hesitate to write them down and send them to me via email. I have received a couple of emails from other investors that are not happy with the Commission and the way they handle this entire matter. I feel they should have at least told the investors of the option Wharram presented (in the attachments above) and let them decide rather than just shutting it all down before the garnered facts. I guess they were too busy bringing forward their false allegations of a large \$5.45 million fraud to be bothered.

Any thoughts you may have Brian would be appreciated. I do have to have my submission back to them later this week. If you have something to say with respect to what I have told you and what you see here, I would appreciate you sending me an email as soon as possible. Again, I just want you to realize there are definitely 2 sides to this story.
